Glasgow Meetings Information on getting to the Gardens

The Hopkirk Room is located at the rear of main range of glasshouses and can be reached by following the road that leads to the management offices. After going through the gate, turn left and continue round where the Hopkirk Room is located on the left after going through another gate.

To retain the tranquillity of the Gardens there is no parking within the grounds but onstreet parking can be found in the surrounding area. If you use Queen Margaret Drive, this is now metered and charges apply Monday to Sunday. The best option is to continue along Great Western passing the Gardens on your right hand side and then turn right at the traffic lights into Kirklee Road. There are usually spaces in the streets around Kelvinside Academy and there is a pedestrian entrance to the Gardens in Ford Road. See overleaf for a map of the surrounding area.

However, if you are a Blue Badge holder there is limited availability in front of the main glasshouse range but if these are full, then you will have to find alternative parking outside the Gardens. The vehicle entrance is in Queen Margaret Drive and remember that pedestrians have priority at all times. The speed limit is 5mph and you must drive with your hazard lights on.

If using public transport the No. 6 bus from the City Centre passes along Great Western Road, ask for the Botanic Gardens. Alternatively, use the subway to Hillhead on Byres Road, then an eight minute walk to the Botanic Gardens.
